RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG OWNERS IN HARRISON:

ORDINANCE # 237 REQUIRES ALL DOG OWNERS TO REGISTER THEIR DOG BY 7 MONTHS OF AGE. LICENSES EXPIRE ON JANUARY 31ST EACH YEAR AND MUST BE RENEWED ANNUALLY. DOGS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CURRENT RABIES VACCINE.

ORDINANCE #416 REQUIRES ALL DOG OWNERS TO PICK UP AFTER THEIR DOGS. FAILURE TO REMOVE DOG FECES WILL RESULT IN THE ISSUANCE OF A SUMMONS AND A COURT FINE OF \$150.00. IF YOU OBSERVE A RESIDENT WHO DOES NOT PICK UP AFTER THEIR DOG PLEASE CONTACT THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT SO FURTHER ACTION CAN BE TAKEN.

ORDINANCE #416 REQUIRES ALL DOGS TO BE KEPT ON A LEASH WHEN OUT IN THE PUBLIC. DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO RUN AT LARGE.

ALL DOG BITES MUST BE REPORTED TO THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT OR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT IMMEDIATELY.

IF YOU DO NOT OWN A DOG BUT DO OBSERVE A RESIDENT NOT FOLLOWING THE ABOVE REGULATIONS PLEASE CONTACT THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO REPORT THEM.
