

How Can The Hudson County Small Business COVID-19 Relief Program Help Your Business?

The Hudson County Small Business Relief Program (HCSBRP) offers grants up to \$20,000 to help businesses located in Hudson County with no more than 25 full-time employees (or their part-time equivalent) affected by the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Your HCSBRP Grant may be used for a range of COVID-19 Pandemic costs resulting from closure, partial closure, or interruption of your small business.

Grants may be used to pay for eligible expenses incurred or anticipated to be incurred from March 15, 2020 through August 31, 2020.

To apply for an HCSBRP Grant, you must certify your business's registration with the State Division of Taxation and provide documentation of the expenses to be addressed by your grant.

Grants will be paid in full at the time of approval. Any funds improperly used or fraudulently obtained will be required to be returned with interest.

Applications will be accepted from August 3rd thru August 14th
