

**PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT
REVERSE 911 CALL
10-31-2020**

This is a message from Mayor James A. Fife and the Harrison Town Council. To hear this message in Spanish press 9.

As you know, **Tuesday, November 3rd is General Election Day**. Due to COVID-19, this Election will be conducted primarily through vote-by-mail ballots.

A Drop Box placed in the rear of the Town Hall near the Police Department entrance is one of the most secure ways to return your vote-by-mail ballot to the Board of Elections. Under 24hr surveillance, only the Board of Elections has access to the contents of the Drop Box. There is no mail-carrier involved in this process and no one outside of the Board will have contact with your ballot.

The Drop Box is available to accept vote-by-mail ballots until 8pm on Election Day.

Because of social distancing guidelines, a limited number of physical polling locations will be open in Harrison, primarily to accept completed vote-by-mail ballots and provisional paper ballot voting for voters who did not vote-by-mail.

Again, vote-by-mail ballots can be placed into the Drop Box in the rear of the Town Hall until 8pm on November 3rd.
